With full height glazing and spacious balconies offering the most spectacular marine views stretching far into the distance, the decision was made for our our AB Composite Decking in colour Chocolate to be installed on our heavy duty plastic battens. All fixings were upgraded to A4 marine grade stainless steel which has now become standard for all jobs.

A lively, cosmopolitan cocktail of boating enthusiasts, bars, restaurants, entertainment and chic shops best sums up this marina, perfect for yachts and motorboats alike, family-friendly and fun. We were asked to supply materials for the amphitheatre at Brighton, the UKs largest marina, and our AB Solid Decking in colour Chocolate was chosen, again using A4 Marine fixings with bullnose boards for the seating areas.
